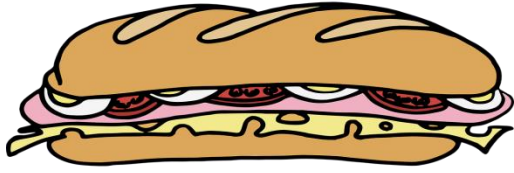

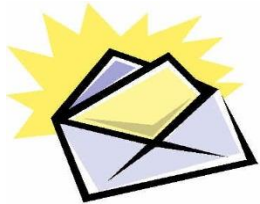
Next Sunday is the **Soup and Sandwich luncheon.** If you would like to pre-order your soup, there is a sign-up sheet on the hall table.
