*Advent Candle Lighting

Reader: Listen to the Prophet Isaiah:

A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. The spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD. Righteousness shall be the belt around his waist, and faithfulness the belt around his loins. The wolf shall live with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the kid, the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them.

Minister: Today we light the second candle, the candle of God's *shalom*. We light it knowing full well that such a peace is elusive, and is almost completely absent in some parts of the world. As we light this candle O Lord, let us listen to what you are saying, for you are speaking *shalom* to your faithful people, and to those who turn their hearts to you. In you, mercy and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other.


Stop down in the library and browse through the many items that were left over from our flea markets. You might find a treasure. Everyone is welcome.
