*A solemn observance, known as "Tenebrae," was first celebrated in the fourth Century A.D. The word "Tenebrae" means darkness or shadows in Latin. In this service, sections of candles will be gradually extinguished in response to the Solemn Reproaches of the Cross. The Church remains darkened until the Great Vigil of Easter, and disciples must contend with the seeming victory of the darkness.*

Leader: I went before you in a pillar of cloud, and you have led me to the judgment hall of Pilate. I scourged your enemies and brought you to a land of freedom, but you have scourged,

mocked, and beaten me. I gave you the water of salvation from the rock, but you have given me gall and left me to thirst, and you have prepared a cross for your Savior.

and you did not visit me, and you have prepared a cross for your Savior

*(Church Fully Darkened)*
