*Advent Candle Lighting

Reader: A voice says "Cry out!" Get you up to a high mountain, O Zion, herald of good tidings. See the LORD God comes with might. It will be said on that day, lo, this is our God; we have waited for him that he might save us. And he will destroy the shroud that is cast over all peoples, the sheet that is spread over all nations; he will swallow up death forever. This is the LORD for whom we have waited; let us be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

Minister: Today we light the third candle, the candle of joy. As we light this candle, may God grant that our hearts be filled with such joy as cannot be contained, but which must be shared. Let the Good News ring out that the Holy One of Israel, God Almighty, has claimed us for his very own children.


